As an exhibitor, you play a key role. Here are some practical ways to help reduce the environmental impact of your participation.

Waste and materials

The most effective way to reduce waste is to prevent it in the first place:

- Choose reusable stand structures whenever possible.
- Limit printed materials such as flyers and programmes.
→ Opt for digital alternatives or use recycled paper.
- Reduce promotional giveaways and prioritize durable, useful items.

Even with the best intentions, some waste is unavoidable. Please make sure to:

- Minimize plastic packaging used for logistics and transportation.
- Sort waste appropriately: wood, cardboard/paper, metal, and plastic.
- Use recyclable or reusable flooring and carpeting materials.
- Take advantage of Palexpo's waste management services, including separate waste collection and dedicated sorting containers, to maximize recycling and reduce disposal costs.

Transport and Logistics

Whenever possible, choose low-impact solutions:

- Travel to Geneva using the most energy-efficient means of transportation available.
- Stay in accommodation close to Palexpo and within walking distance.
- Work with partners that are committed to sustainable practices.
- Give preference to local suppliers.
